



Part A: Seerah
First Year of Revelation
Age 40; 12 BH







Key events before the Prophethood



- ❖The Prophet≝ was born in Rabiul Awal in 571 AD.
- ❖ He was entrusted to Haleemah (RA) for nursing.
- ❖ His mother died at the age of six and was entrusted to his grandfather and then to his uncle Abu Talib.
- ❖ He worked as shepherd early in his life.
- ❖ He was happy to join Hilf ul Fudoul an alliance of virtuous.
- ❖ He married Khadija (RA) at the age of 25 and had six children.
- ❖ He was known for his noble characters in Makkah as As-Sadiq and Al-Ameen even before prophethood.








Seclusion to the Cave Hira



- ❖The Prophet[™] never worshipped any idol, and he was not happy with the moral evils and idolatry in the society.
- As he was reaching the age of 40, he used to seclude himself and spend time pondering and meditating.
- ❖ He used to spend hours/days in a cave nearby Makkah called Hira.
- ❖He used to see dreams that would come true the next day.
- ❖ Even rocks used to say salaam to him.
- This was all indication that he was a chosen one and of the coming revelations.







First Revelation



- ❖It was the month of Ramadan and night of Qadr.
- ❖The Prophet[™] was meditating in Cave Hira, and an angel appeared.
- ❖ Angel Jibril (showing the Ayah) told him to read.
- ❖The Prophet[™] was unlettered so he responded "I cannot".
- ❖ Angel asked him second time and the Prophet[™] replied the same.
- ❖ Angel embraced him tight and asked him to read third time, he started reading the verses.
- ❖ First five Ayah of Surah Al-Alaq (1-5) were revealed.









First Revelation (Wahy)



- ❖The Prophet[™] returned home terrified and told his wife that his life might be in danger.
- ❖He asked Khadijah (RA) to cover him up.
- ❖She reassured the Prophet≝ reminded him of his good characters such as:
 - Keeping good relations with kith and kin;
 - Speaking truth;
 - Helping poor and destitute;
 - Entertaining guests;
 - Assisting those who are stricken with calamities;
- *Khadija (RA) took him to her cousin and a saint Waraqa bin Noufal who confirmed his prophethood.





Second Revelation



❖Hiatus

- The revelation paused for some period after the first Wahy.
- The Prophet became very depressed.
- But Jibril (AS) appeared before him and reassured him that he was the messenger of Allah.

Second Wahy

- One day the Prophet was walking, and he heard a sound.
- He looked up and saw Jibril (AS) in his original form sitting on a throne in the sky.
- He trembled and rushed back to Khadija (RA) and asked her to wrap him up.
- Subsequently the second Wahy is revealed.
- The revelations continued and dawah of the Prophet began from this event.









The First Believers




- ❖The Prophet[®] commenced the Dawah
 - After the commandment to call people towards the religion, the Prophet first started preaching to the people who were close to him.
- Close relatives who accepted his message
 - First woman to believe: Khadijah bint Khuwalid (RA)
 - First man to believe: Abu Bakr (RA)
 - First child to believe: Ali bin Abi Taalib (RA)
 - First slave to believe: Zaid ibn Haaritha (RA)
- Other early believers
 - Some of the first people who believed started preaching within their close contacts.














Ayath Revealed Per Year





Note: These numbers are approximate and could vary according to different scholars








Words Revealed Per Year

- Surah/Verses revealed in the First Year of Nabawi
 - Al-Alaq, Ayah 1-5
 - Al-Muddathir, Ayah 1-7
 - Al-Muzzammil, Ayah 1-8
 - Al-Fatihah, Ayah 1-7





Surah Al-Alaq (96)



اقْرَأُ بِاسُمِ رَبِّكَ الَّذِي خَلَقَ -

Recite in the name of your Lord who created [96:1]

خَلَقَ الْإِنسَانَ مِنْ عَلَقٍ -

Created man from a clinging substance[96:2]

اقْرَأُ وَرَبُّكَ الْأَكْرَمُ -

Recite, and your Lord is the most Generous[96:3]

الَّذِي عَلَّمَ بِالْقَلَمِ -

Who taught by the pen[96:4]

عَلَّمَ الْإِنسَانَ مَا لَمْ يَعُلَمُ -

Taught man that which he knew not[96:5].

- Key points emphasized in these Ayah:
 - Recite (emphasized twice)
 - Introduction of the Lord
 - The Cherisher
 - The Creator
 - The most Generous
 - The Teacher









Surah Al-Muddathir (74)



- يَا أَيُّهَا الْمُدَّثِّرُ 74:1 •
- O you who covers himself [with a garment],
 - قُمُ فَأَنذِرُ 2:47 •
 - Arise and warn
 - وَرَبَّكَ فَكَبِّرُ 3:47
 - And your Lord glorify
 - وَثِيَابَكَ فَطَهِّرُ 4:4 •
 - And your clothing purify
 - وَالرُّجْزَ فَاهُجُرُ 74:5
 - · And uncleanliness avoid
 - وَلَا تَمْنُن تَسْتَكُثِرُ 74:6 •
- And do not confer favor to acquire more
 وَلِرَبِّكَ فَاصْبِرُ 74:7
 - And for your Lord be patient.`

- Key points in these Ayah
 - Commandment to give Dawah
 - Glorification of the Lord
 - Emphasis on Personal hygiene
 - To be Patient for the sake of Lord









Surah Al-Muzzammil (73)



- يَا أَيُّهَا ٱلمُزَّمِّلُ ١
- O you wrapped 'in your clothes'! قُم ٱلَّيْلَ إِلَّا قَلِيلًا ِ ٢
- Stand all night 'in prayer' except a little—
 - نِّصْفَهُ ۚ أُوِ ٱنقُصْ مِنْهُ قَلِيلًا ٣ •
 - 'pray' half the night, or a little less,
 - أَوْ زِدْ عَلَيْهِ وَرَتِّلِ ٱلْقُرْءَانَ تَرْتِيلًا ٤ •
- or a little more—and recite the Quran 'properly' in a measured way.
 - إِنُّا سَنُلُقِي عَلَيْكَ قَوْلًا ثَقِيلًا ٥ •
 - 'For' We will soon send upon you a weighty revelation.
 - إِنَّ نَاشِئَةَ ٱلَّيْلِ هِيَ أَشَدُّ وَطُهًا وَأَقْوَمُ قِيلًا ٦
- Indeed, worship in the night is more impactful and suitable for recitation.
 - إِنَّ لَكَ فِي ٱلنَّهَارِ سَبْحًا طَوِيلًا ٧ •
 - For during the day you are over-occupied 'with worldly duties'.
 - وَٱذۡكُرِ ٱسۡمَ رَبِّكَ وَتَبَتَّلُ إِلَيْهِ تَبْتِيلًا ۗ ٨
 - 'Always' remember the Name of your Lord, and devote yourself to Him wholeheartedly.

- Key points in these Ayah
 - Emphasis on Personal hygiene
 - Encouragement for Night worship (Tahajjud)
 - Highlighting the importance of remembering Allah









Al-Fatihah (1)



- بِسُمِ ٱللهِ ٱلرَّحْمَانِ ٱلرَّحِيمِ ١ •
- In the Name of Allah—the Most Compassionate, Most Merciful.
 - ٱلْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ رَبِّ ٱلْعَلَمِينَ ٢ •
 - All praise is for Allah—Lord of all worlds,
 - ٱلرَّحْمَانِ ٱلرَّحِيمِ ٣ •
 - the Most Compassionate, Most Merciful,
 - مَللِكِ يَوْمِ ٱلدِّينِ ٤ •
 - Master of the Day of Judgment.
 - إِيَّاكَ نَعْبُدُ وَإِيَّاكَ نَسْتَعِينُ ٥ •
- You 'alone' we worship and You 'alone' we ask for help.
 - ٱهْدِنَا ٱلصِّرَٰطَ ٱلْمُسْتَقِيمَ ٦٠٠
 - Guide us along the Straight Path,
 - صِرْطَ ٱلَّذِينَ أَنْعَمْتَ عَلَيْهِمْ غَيْرِ ٱلْمَغْضُوبِ عَلَيْهِمْ وَلَا ٱلضَّآلِّينَ ٧ •
- the Path of those You have blessed—not those You are displeased with, or those who are astray.

- Key points in this Surah:
 - More names of Allah are introduced
 - Day of judgement is mentioned
 - Asked to make dua for guidance






















Takeaway 1: Connect with Allah



يَنْزِلُ رَبُّنَا تَبَارَكَ وَتَعَالَى كُلَّ لَيْلَةٍ إِلَى السَّمَاءِ الدُّنْيَا حِينَ يَبْقَى ثُلُثُ اللَّيْلِ الآخِرُ .يَقُولُ مَنْ يَدْعُونِي فَأَسْتَجِيبَ لَهُ مَنْ يَسْأَلُنِي فَأُعْطِيَهُ مَنْ يَسْتَغْفِرُنِي فَأَغْفِرَ لَهُ "

Allah's Messenger (p.b.u.h) said, "Our Lord, the Blessed, the Superior, comes every night down on the nearest Heaven to us when the last third of the night remains, saying: "Is there anyone to invoke Me, so that I may respond to invocation? Is there anyone to ask Me, so that I may grant him his request? Is there anyone seeking My forgiveness, so that I may forgive him?"

Takeaway 2: Convey the message



وعن عبد الله بن عمرو بن العاص رضي الله عنهما أن النبي صلى الله عليه وسلم قال: "بلغوا عني ولو آية وحدثوا عن بني إسرائيل ولا حرج، ومن كذب علي متعمدًا فليتبوأ مقعده من النار"

'Abdullah bin 'Amr bin Al-'As (May Allah be pleased with them) reported: The Prophets said, "Convey from me even an Ayah of the Qur'an; relate traditions from Banu Israel, and there is no restriction on that; but he who deliberately forges a lie against me let him have his abode in the Hell." [Sahih Al- Bukhari].





Takeaway 3: Dua



اللهم آت نفسي تقواها، وزكها أنت خير من زكاها، أنت وليها ومولاها، *

*Zaid bin Arqam (May Allah be pleased with him) reported: The Messenger of Allah would supplicate: "O Allah! Grant me the sense of piety and purify my soul as You are the Best to purify it. You are its Guardian and its Protecting Friend." [Sahih Al-Muslim]




