Recap of Makkah Events



- ❖ The Prophet ≝ secludes to the cave Hira at the age of 40 years.
- ❖ First five verses of the Surah Alaq are revealed.
- ❖ After a brief gap the second revelation happens, and commandment is given to start dawah.
- Close relatives and friends accepts his message and subsequently other close friends follows.
- ❖ The early believers used to meet at Dar Al-Arqam.
- Invitation given to the extended family, subsequently open dawah begins.
- Quraish starts persecuting Muslims, first migration to Abyssinia occurs.
- ❖ Humzah (RA) and Omar (RA) accepts Islam.
- Second migration to Abyssinia occurs.

- * The disbelievers of Makkah tries bargaining and renunciation to stop the message.
- ❖ Social boycott of Banu Hashim and Muslims.
- ❖ Khadija (RA) and Abu Talib dies, year of grief.
- ❖ The Prophet ≝ travels to Taif for dawah but the people rejects him. He returns extremely disappointed.
- ❖ Six men from Madinah meets the Prophet ≝ and accepts Islam.





The Journey of Isra and Miraj



- ❖This happened about 12-16 months prior to the migration.
- ❖Isra Night journey from Makkah to Jerusalem.
- ❖Miraj Ascension to the heavens
- *At Jerusalem he led prayer for all prophets.
- ❖He ﷺ went to various heavens and met some prophets.
- ❖He ﷺ saw some of the punishments of Hell and some of the rewards of Paradise.
- ❖He ≝ saw Jibril (AS) in his original form, met Allah, and received last two verses of Surah Baqarah.
- ❖He ≝ received five daily prayers as a gift from Allah.





The Journey of Isra and Miraj



- ❖When the Prophet [™] narrates the story of the trip to Masjid Al-Aqsa and then to Heavens, the disbelievers of Makkah denies and mocks.
- ❖ Abu Bakr (RA) becomes As-Siddeeq by testifying that the prophet is telling truth about his journey.
- ❖The Prophet [™] continues his Dawah despite mocking and resistance.






First Pledge of Aqabah




- ❖ Last year (eleventh year), six men heard the message of the Prophet ≝ during pilgrimage time and started spreading in Madinah.
- *During the pilgrimage season in this year (twelfth), came a group of twelve disciples ready to acknowledge the message.
- They embraced the religion and pledged to spread the message to others in Madinah.
- This is referred to as the First Pledge of Aqabah as the pledge occurred at a place a called valley of Aqabah.
- ❖ After the pledge, the Prophet [™] appointed Musa'b bin Umair (RA) to teach the doctrines of Islam to the people in Madinah.








Ayath Revealed Per Year

Main Themes




Surah (verses)	Main Theme					
17. Isra (111)	Strong emphasis is reiterated to accept the message of the Holy Quran. The example of Pharoah and his destruction is given to warn the disbelievers of Makkah that if they deny the Prophet their consequence will be similar to the Pharaoh The good news of conquest of Makkah and the conquest of Bait ul Maqdas is prophesied.					
53. An-Najm (62)	The invitation to believe in the revelations given to the Prophetsinstead of depending on their false gods (Laat, Uzza, Manaat and She'raa. Avoid major sins and do righteous deeds, everyone will bear his own burden, only own effort will benefit, the efforts of other will not benefit.

Might of the Qur'an, Stories of the Prophets



❖Surah Isra

- Even if all humans and Jinn collaborated, they will not be able make something like the Quran.
- Allah revealed the Quran in parts so that the message could be absorbed easily.





Characters and Commandments



Surah Isra

- Ten Commandments
 - 1. Worship Allah alone
 - 2. Be good to parents (when they become old)
 - 3. Give rights to relative, the needy, travelers.
 - 4. Do not spend wastefully (those who waste are like brothers of Shaitan)
 - 5. Do not kill your children out of fear of poverty
 - 6. Do not approach adultery
 - 7. Do not kill a forbidden soul
 - 8. Do not approach the property of orphans
 - 9. Fulfill the covenant
 - 10. Give full measure when measuring & do not walk upon earth with insolence
- Iblis will try to misguide us with his sound (useless talks, music etc.,)
- Establish prayer, recite Quran at Fajr time, pray Tahajjud
- Don't be too loud nor too low in Salah





Seerah-Quran Connection



- ❖ The Prophet [™] was taken to heavens and shown great signs to increase his eman and prepare him for the upcoming challenges
- ❖ In Surah Isra, Allah speaks about the history of Bani Israel, as the Prophet was to deal with them in Madinah
- ❖ In Surah Isra, Allah indicates that if the disbelievers force the Prophet to leave Makkah (Hijrah) then they will not stay sny longer.
- ❖ Allah teaches the dua for Hijrah indicating Hijrah is coming soon.
- The Muslims were to become a new Ummah, so the commandments given earlier to Bani Israel are reiterated.

















Takeaway 1: Realize the blessings of Salah and never miss it



- Anas bin Malik narrated: "On the Night of Isra, fifty prayers were made obligatory upon the Prophet. Then it was decreased until it was made five. Then it was called out: 'O Muhammad! Indeed My Word does not change; these five prayers will be recorded for you as fifty." Jami` at-Tirmidhi 213 (https://sunnah.com/tirmidhi:213)
- ❖It is narrated on the authority of Jabir that he heard the Apostle (may peace and blessings be upon him) saying. Verily between man and between polytheism and unbelief is the negligence of prayer. Sahih Muslim 82a (https://sunnah.com/muslim:82a)





Takeaway 2: Try to pray Tahajjud at least sometimes

Is there anyone to ask Me, so that I may grant him his request? Is there anyone seeking My forgiveness, so that I may forgive him?"

Takeaway 3: Do not squander wealth

Malik related to me from Suhayl ibn Abi Salih from his father from Abu Hurayra that the Messenger of Allah, may Allah bless him and grant him peace, said, "Allah is pleased with three things from you, and He is angry with three things from you. He is pleased that you worship Him and do not associate anything with Him, and that you take hold of the rope of Allah altogether, and that you give good counsel to the one to whom Allah gives command over you. He is angry with you for gossip, squandering property, and asking too many questions."

O Allah, make me of those who return to You often in repentance and make me of those who remain clean and pure.











