#### Recap of Makkah Events



- ❖ The Prophet ≝ secludes to the cave Hira at the age of 40 years.
- ❖ First five verses of the Surah Alaq are revealed.
- ❖ After a brief gap the second revelation happens, and commandment is given to start dawah.
- Close relatives and friends accepts his message and subsequently other close friends follows.
- ❖ The early believers used to meet at Dar Al-Arqam.
- Invitation given to the extended family, subsequently open dawah begins.
- Quraish starts persecuting Muslims, first migration to Abyssinia occurs.
- ❖ Humzah (RA) and Omar (RA) accepts Islam.
- Second migration to Abyssinia occurs.

❖ The disbelievers of Makkah tries bargaining and renunciation to stop the message.








# Social Boycott




- ❖The boycott was devastating to the entire clan of Banu Hashim.
- ❖Several months the Muslim had to live in misery.
- \*Food was very scarce; sometimes they had to eat the leaves of trees and the skin of the animals.
- ❖The children would cry in hunger, particularly suckling babies. It is reported that their cry would be heard all over the valley.
- The Quraysh told the merchants not to sell any goods to the Muslims. Prices were increased to prevent them from buying even essentials.
- Some kind people among the Quraish used to smuggle secretly the food to the valley.
- ❖Despite such grim circumstances, the Prophet ≝ never ceased inviting non-Muslims to Islam.
- ❖ He was particularly active during the time of Hajj.








## Ayath Revealed Per Year





Note: These numbers are approximate and could vary according to different scholars








#### Words Revealed Per Year

## Main Themes




Surah (verses)	Main Theme
85. Buruj (22)	People have to undergo the tests and trials after entering into Isla. Those who oppress the Muslims cannot save themselves from the retribution of Allah. Believe in the holy Quran.
86. Tariq (17)	Man has to give an account of his deeds in front of Allah. The holy Quran is a decisive word. The souls will be refreshed with the bounty of Quran
89. Fajr (30)	The satisfied souls who accept the Quranic invitation of Tawheed and life of hereafter and establish the social justice which will achieve Allah'

# Tawheed, Might of Allah and Signs of Allah



#### Allah's attributes mentioned

- Allah's grip is severe;
- He is the one who originates and resurrects all;
- He is the Doer of whatever He wills;

#### Signs

- Dawn, night, ten days;
- Allah can give punishment anytime;





# Qayamah, Jannah and Jahannum



- ❖ Those who afflict Muslims will find their abode in Jahannum.
- \* Those who entered Jannah are the one who achieved true success.
- ❖ Earth will be crushed, judgement day established with angles ranked, Hell will be brought forth, people will realize after seeing the Hell, tranquil soul will be invited to enter into Paradise.





# Might of the Qur'an, Stories of the Prophets



- Story of Ashab ul Uqdood
  - To save eaman they gave up their lives
- Might of the Quran
  - The Qur'an is recorded in Preserved Tablet (Louhe Mahfooz)
- ❖ Mention of the A'ad, Thamud and Firaun





#### Characters and Commandments



- ❖ Bad characters (particularly materialism) of the disbeliever are highlighted
  - Not respecting orphans;
  - Not feeding poor;
  - Not giving the inheritance correctly and eating it all for themselves;
  - Unjustly accumulate wealth;






#### Seerah-Quran Connection



- Lessons are given to Muslims
  - People of Ukhthud gave up their lives to preserve their faith, so Muslims should stay steadfast during trials and tribulations.
  - Even if you die during trials, there is a greatest triumph for you ie Jannah.
- Disbelievers are warned that if they torture Muslims they will face severe punishment.







