- The second migration to Ethiopia took place.

- Quraish boycotted the Muslims and the tribe of Banu Hashim and hung an agreement in the Kaaba for three years.
- ❖ The boycott ended in 10th Nabawi with the effort of some good people from Quraish.
- In 10th Nabawi (Year of Grief), Khadija (RA) and Abu Talib died.
- The Prophet visited Taif to invite them to Islam but they rejected him.
