

MAKKI PERIOD 4





- During the pilgrimage, six men from Madinah met the Prophet and accepted Islam.
- Journey of Isra and Miraj
- First pledge of Aqaba with twelve people of Madinah.
- After the pledge, the Prophet appointed Mus'ab ibn Umair (RA) to teach Islam to the people of Madinah.
- Second pledge of Aqaba with 75 people from Madinah accepting Islam
- * The Prophet gave to migrate to Madinah





Allah rejects Pharaoh's attempt to believe right before drowning; Believing close to punishment is useless.



Stories of previous nations being destroyed; that was the consequence of not believing in their prophets.



The story of Yusuf (AS) shows that those who are patient will ultimately succeed



Proofs of Tawheed, Qiyamah, and Risalah (prophethood)

For those of understanding, the Quran is clear evidence.



Proofs of Tawheed, consequence of denying the message; Invite to Islam with wisdom.

Proofs of punishment and reward in the hereafter; Refutation of the false concept of intercession by their gods



Signs of Tawheed, Risalah, and Qiyamah



Through the stories of Iblees and the previous nations, Allah warns those who deny his commands.



Qualities of people who have a better afterlife than worldly life. Allah teaches how to make group decisions.



Affirmation that the revelation is true and rejection of Shirk
