- ❖ The Prophet ﷺ took a large army to Tabuk to respond to the Romans.
- ❖ In 9th Hijri, Muslims took control of Hajj and eradicated all the practices of the time of ignorance.
- ❖ Allah revealed verses prohibiting polytheists from entering Makkah.
- ❖ Many chiefs from different tribes visited the Prophet ﷺ; this year is called the Year of Delegations.
- ❖ In 10th Hijri, the Prophet ﷺ performed Hajj and gave the famous last sermon and instructed those present to convey to the absent.
- ❖ The Prophet ﷺ appointed Usamah (RA) as the leader of an army to fight the Romans.
- ❖ Before his death, the Prophet ﷺ freed his slaves, cleared his debts, appointed Abu Bakr as Imam of prayer, and warned Muslims from taking his grave as a place of worship.
- ❖ The Prophet ﷺ left this world on Monday 12th Rabi Al-Awwal at the age of 63.
- ❖ His last words were: "O Allah forgive me, have mercy on me, and admit me into the company of the most exalted companionship on high"

Believers are taught etiquettes of respecting the Prophet ﷺ and were given directions to deal with each other.

التَّوْبَةُ
Tawba

Instructions on how to deal with the Arab polytheists, People of the Book, and the hypocrites. Commentary on the expedition of Tabuk.

الْبَيِّنَاتُ
Bayyinah

Greatness of Allah; The People of the Book disbelieve only because of their arrogance.

النَّصْرُ
Nasr

Instruction to glorify Allah and do Istighfar when Allah gives victory.



KEY LESSONS

- ❖ Do not exaggerate the status of the Prophet ﷺ as Abu Bakr (RA) reminded Muslims after the Prophet ﷺ's death.
- ❖ Avoid being in debt as the Prophet ﷺ did not pray the funeral of people in debt.
- ❖ In times of success, do lots of Istighfar and glorify Allah.
