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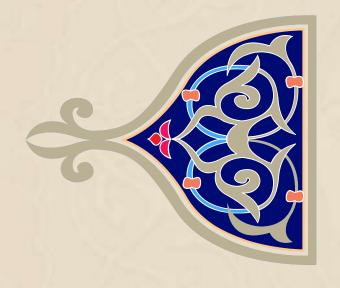

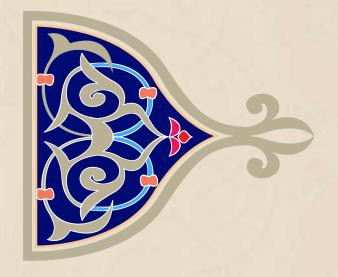

  - Our final session, session seven, discusses the manners and etiquette of learning Hadith while culminating the course with a conclusion












## Reward of Deeds Depends on Intention



#### Quran

• Literal word of Allah revealed through Jibril AS.

#### \*Seerah

• Biographical account or biography of the life of the Prophet ...

#### \*Sunnah

• Actions, saying, approvals and disapprovals of the Prophet ...

#### \*Hadith

• Recorded reports or narrations of the actions, saying, and approval of the Prophet ...





## Necessity of Sunnah



## Six things to understand

- 1. Allah commands us to obey the Prophet in the Quran.
- 2. The Prophet did receive revelation outside the Quran.
- 3. The sayings of the Prophet are needed.
- 4. The hadith sciences being 'manmade' does not make it especially unreliable.
- 5. Most hadith being non-definitive does not mean we are not required to follow them.
- 6. There are wisdoms for Allah not putting everything in the Quran.





## 1. Allah's Commandment



Obey Allah and Obey Messenger

- Mentioned at least five times in the Quran
- Two separate commands; Obey Allah and Obey the Messenger
- Love of Allah is in the following of His Messenger

- Say, 'O Prophet,' "If you 'sincerely' love Allah, then follow me [3:31]
- ❖ Allah and His Messenger ≝ Ultimate authorities

• O you who have believed, obey Allah and obey the Messenger and the leaders among you. And if you disagree over anything, refer it to Allah and the Messenger [4:59]





### 1. Allah's Commandment



- ❖ The Prophet ઃ Final Judge
  - فَلَا وَرَبِّكَ لَا يُؤْمِنُونَ حَتَّى يُحَكِّمُوكَ فِيْمَا شَجَرَ بَيْنَهُمْ ثُمَّ لَا يَجِدُوا فِي آنَفْسِهِمْ حَرَجًا مِّمَّا قَضَيْتَ وَيُسَلِّمُوا تَسْلِيْمًا
  - But no! By your Lord, they will never be 'true' believers until they accept you 'O Prophet' as the judge in their disputes, and find no resistance within themselves against your decision and submit wholeheartedly. [4:65]
- The Prophet An excellent example to follow لَقَدُ كَانَ لَكُمْ فِي رَسُولِ اللهِ اُسْوَةٌ حَسَنَةٌ لِّمَنْ كَانَ يَرْجُوا اللهَ وَالْيَوْمَ الْأَخِرَ وَذَكَرَ اللهَ كَثِيرًا " لَقَدُ كَانَ لَكُمْ فِي رَسُولِ اللهِ اُسْوَةٌ حَسَنَةٌ لِّمَنْ كَانَ يَرْجُوا اللهَ وَالْيَوْمَ الْأَخِرَ وَذَكَرَ اللهَ كَثِيرًا "
  - Indeed, in the Messenger of Allah you have an excellent example for whoever has hope in Allah and the Last Day, and remembers Allah often [33:21]





## 2. The Prophet Received Other Revelation



- ❖ The Prophet <sup>™</sup> received other revelations in addition to the Quran
- He spoke not from his own inclination

- Your companion [Muhammad] has not strayed, nor has he erred, Nor does he speak from [his own] inclination. It is not but a revelation revealed [53:2-4]
- ❖ The Prophet ા never spoke from his desires
- **\*** Example:
  - Allah says He legislated the qiblah to Jerusalem, but no such verse exists in the Quran. So, it was something given to the Prophet soutside the Quran.





# 3. Importance of the Sayings of the Prophet



- Just the generational practice is not sufficient.
- ❖ We need written record of the sayings of the Prophet ≝.
- ❖ As long as the transmission is authentic we are required to follow.





## 4. Both Quran and Sunnah are preserved



- Some people criticize the sciences of hadith as being manmade.
- ❖ However, even the sciences of the Quran are manmade. After all, the Quran was written by men, compiled by men, carried to the different lands by men, and memorized generation to generation by men.
- ❖ Allah says in the Quran 《Indeed, it is We who sent down the Reminder and indeed, We will be its guardian.》 (15:9)
- ❖ Although some people said 《Reminder》 here means Quran, the word itself is broad enough to include hadith.





## 4. Both Quran and Sunnah are preserved



- ❖ Allah protected both the reminder in the Quran and the Sunnah.
- ❖ He protected the Sunnah by creating scholars who memorized the ahadith, created a science to classify them, authenticated the authentic and weakened the weak, and collected them into the many collections we have today.
- So, both the Quran and Sunnah were preserved by the hands of men with Allah's power guiding the process.
- The only difference is that the Quran is mostly definitive while the ahadith are usually non-definitive, but both must be followed.





#### 5. Definitive and Non-Definitive



- ❖ Definitive knowledge is that knowledge which is known to be true with zero doubt.
- Non-definitive knowledge is that knowledge which is known to be true but with the possibility of some doubt. It can still be strongly proven, but it has some room for doubt.
- The Quran's transmission is definitive.





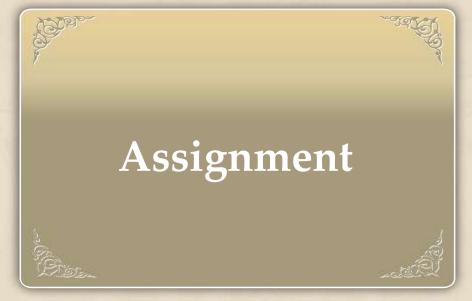
## 6. Wisdoms of Having the Sunnah

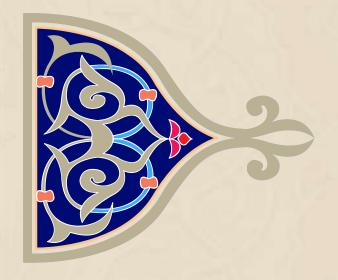


- Why not the details mentioned in the Quran?
  - It is not a legal textbookk
  - It was sent down as a concise book of guidance and point to the correct direction (like the Sunnah)
- Does the Quran contain everything?
  - Allah says (And We have sent down to you the Book as clarification for all things and as guidance and mercy and good tidings for the Muslims.) (16:89)
  - Clarification everything meaning it also refers to the Sunnah
- ❖ Allah gave the Prophet ﷺ a high status
  - Obligating people to follow his sayings and actions is one way Allah raised the Prophet \*\*s mention and status.

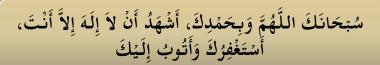
