- * The main purpose of the Bird's Eye View of the Quran is to present brief summaries of the Quran page by page. Some of the benefits are:
 - You can learn the general message of the Quran page by page
 - * You can remember the key message of the verse or group of verses while reciting
 - * This can generate further interest in learning and understanding the Quran
 - * It can be use for a Daur-e-Quran (going over the brief message of the entire Quran in 26 sessions) which is valuable, particularly in Ramadan.
- Some details of the methodology are:
 - * 15-line Quran is used, a soft copy of which can downloaded here
 - * Verses on each page are grouped based on a common message and the key pointers and some obvious lessons where possible are highlighted on the side. However, for detailed explanations, you should refer to translations and tafsir books.
 - The sessions are divided into 26 parts and each part is presented separately.

- Consequence of being ungrateful

Praise and Might of Allah

- Allah is Wise, Acquainted, Merciful, Forgiving, and Knower of Unseen
- Everything big or small is written in a book

- Those who believe and do good deeds have forgiveness
- Those who struggle against Allah's verses have punishment
- Good people knows that the Quran is truth, and it will lead to Allah
- Bad people make fun of the Day of Judgement

Story of Saba

- Allah gave blessings to them, but they were ungrateful, so Allah sent flood that damaged the dam
- He replaced good gardens with bad
- Allah punishes those who are ungrateful
- They were ungrateful
- Allah made their travel to the blessed cities easy, but they were ungrateful
- Due to the flood, they were forced to migrate, and the place Saba completely disappeared
- They were trapped into the trick of Iblees (making them ungrateful)

Address to the Disbelievers

- They call gods other than Allah
- Their gods do not even have power equal to an atom's weight

Deniers of hereafter are lost
 No one is beyond the reach of Allah.

- He can punish anytime.
- Abd um-Muneeb (servant who turns toward Allah) realizes this.

Blessings to Dawood AS

- Mountains and birds used to praise
 Allah along with him
- Allah softened iron for him to make armors

Blessings to Sulaiman AS

- Allah subdued the winds for him
- He could control the Jinn and make them work for him
- Allah tells both Dawood and Sulaiman AS to be grateful

Death of Sulaiman AS

- Jinn do not know the unseen
- They continued working until Sulaiman AS's staff fell down

Followers will blame their leaders

Rewards based on Deeds only

- Wealthy people think they will be rewarded in the hereafter like they were given in this world.
- But, in the hereafter, Allah will reward based on their deeds
- This world is a test

Lesson:

 Having wealth does not necessarily mean Allah is happy with us

 On the day of judgement Allah will ask the Angels whether they were worshiped

Address to the Disbelievers

 There is no intercession for the disbelievers

- The Prophet SAW is asked to tell them: Allah will judge on Qiyamah about who is on guidance
- The Prophet SAW is just a warner and giver of good news
- Qiyamah will come at its appointed time

Deniers of the Quran

Those who deny the Quran will curse each other on Qiyamah (leaders and their followers)

منزله منزله

The Prophet SAW is asked to tell them:

- Truth has come and there is no foundation or firmness to the falsehood
- If I am astray, it is on me
- Believing when they are terrified (during death, punishment, on the day of judgement) will be of no benefit

Surah Fatir (Originator)

- Rejection of the belief that angels are gods
- Invitation to the Tawheed
- Qualities of the People of knowledge

Angels

- All Praise to Allah that He created angels with different types and powers
- Allah gives and holds the provisions
- Allah asks: Who could give other than Him?

ومن يقنت ٢٢ فاطرهم ٩

- Angels will respond that the disbelievers actually used to worship the Jinn
- On Qiyamah, no one can harm or benefit anyone
- Disbelievers who reject now will see their fate the day of Qiyamah

Reminders to the Disbelievers

- Allah addresses them in a soft way
- They are asked to think again individually and in groups about the Prophet SAW
- The Prophet SAW has been your companion (think about his characters)
- He doesn't ask for any compensation

Signs and Blessings of Allah

فاطره

- Sweet and Salty waters do not mix
- Tender meat (fish etc.)
- Ornaments
- Ships
- Day and night

 Disbelievers' gods are useless and helpless

Address to mankind

- You need Allah and He is free of any need
- He can bring forth new creation, it is easy for Him
- No bearer will bear the burden of others

فاطره ومن يقنت ٢٢

 To the Prophet SAW: Previous messengers were also denied so do not grieve

To mankind:

ومن يقنت ٢٢

- World life should not delude you
- Shaitan is an enemy
- Everyone gets their reward by their deeds
- Shaitan makes evil deeds look attractive
- Example of resurrection is like dead land becoming alive after rain
- All honor belongs to Allah and only He can grant it
- Good deeds raises Kalima Tayyiba (Kalme Tawheed)

Lesson:

- Whoever wants honor he should do good deeds
- Allah is the one who created humans with dust
- Everything is written in the Book

- Allah is appreciative of their actions
- Allah gave the Book to the Prophet ## which is truth,

Three Groups

- Allah mentions three groups
- Group 1: Who wronged themselves (rejected the message). As a result, Allah will punish them on Qiyamah, and they escape the punishment
- Group 2: Who were moderate
- Group 3: Who believed and were foremost in doing good deeds. As a result, Allah will reward them on Qiyamah with Jannah (ornaments, silk clothes, no harm, and no tiredness)

ومن يقنت ٢٢ فاطره ٢٣٩

To the Prophet SAW

- Like the blind and sighted people are not the same, not all people will believe.
- You are just a warner

Qualities of the People of the Knowledge

- They ponder over the signs of Allah (rain, different colored fruits, different types of mountains, various animals)
- They fear Allah, read the Book, establish Salah, and gives charity
- This is a trade without any loss

To the Disbelievers:

يل ۲۷

- Walk on the earth and see the consequence of the disbelievers
- Every nation has a time. If Allah wanted to catch them instantly no one would survive on earth

Surah Ya-Sin (Yasin)

- Truthfulness of the Prophet SAW
- Emphasis on Tawheed and Resurrection
- Allah gives testimony that the Prophet[®] is among the messengers who is calling to the right path
- It is their fault that they are rejecting the message.
- Allah prevents them from realizing the truth

To the Disbelievers:

If you disbelieve, the loss is yours

ومن يقنت ٢٢

- What have your idols made on earth?
- They claim that if a prophet was sent, they would believe. But they rejected the prophets
- Allah's sunnah will not change (i.e., if a nation denies the message of Allah they will be punished)

Story of People of the City

- The man who believed was killed
- Allah enters him to Jannah, and he wishes that the people would know that he was in Jannah
- Allah sent punishment to that city

Lesson:

 The quality of believer is such that even if he is harmed by the people, he wishes good for them

Signs of Allah

- Land is brought to life
- Fruits
- Pairs in nature
- Night and day

To the Prophet SAW:

- Whether you warn or not, it is same.
 They will not believe.
- You can only warn people who fear Allah without seeing.
- Allah will raise the dead, and he has recorded everything

Story of People of a City

- Allah sent two prophets.
- They rejected them, so He sent a third prophet.
- They rejected and threatened them too
- A man from their own city came and asked them to believe in the prophets

Scene of Qiyamah

- Believers will be in Paradise
- Those who were misguided by Shaitan will be in Jahannum
- The disbelievers' mouths will be closed, and their hands and legs will testify.

- If Allah wanted, he could have taken away their sight and movement. Why aren't they thinking then?
- The Prophet does not know poetry.
 He only brings the Quran
- So that he can warn those who are alive

Signs of Allah

- Sun and moon
- Ships

Lesson:

ومألى٢٣

 The purpose of showing these signs is so that we become grateful to Allah. (worship Allah alone)

Attitude of the Disbelievers

- When signs are shown, they reject them.
- When they are asked to spend, they say Allah didn't feed the poor, so they have no responsibility to do so. This is a clear misguidance
- They would ask for the punishment.
- Allah can bring punishment anytime

Scene of Qiyamah

- Trumpet will be blown
- People will rise from their graves

 Allah made cattle that gives us many benefits

 The disbelievers till takes gods besides Allah for help.

Those gods cannot help them anything

 To Prophet: Don't grieve because of them

Humans are Argumentative
